

Selection from Hadith (Saying of the Prophet Muhammad).

1. Ibn Umar reported that the people saw the new moon (of Ramadan). So, I informed the Messenger of Allah (peace and blessing of Allah be upon him) that I had seen the new moon. Upon this the Holy Prophet observed fasting and ordered the people to observe the fasts of Ramadan. (Sunan Abu Dawud)
2. One night Allah's Apostle offered the prayer in the Mosque and the people followed him. The next night he also offered the prayer and too many people gathered. On the third and the fourth nights more people gathered, but Allah's Apostle did not come out to them. In the morning he said, "I saw what you were doing and nothing but the fear that it (i.e. the prayer) might be enjoined on you, stopped me from coming to you." And that happened in the month of Ramadan. (Sahih Al-Bukhari)
3. Abu Harairah reported that The Prophet (peace_be_upon_him) said: If anyone breaks his fast one day in Ramadan without a concession granted to him by Allah, a perpetual fast will not atone for it. (Sunan Abu Dawud)
4. Ibn Abas reported Allah's Apostle said, "The Night of Qadr is in the last ten nights of the month (Ramadan), either on the first nine or in the last (remaining) seven nights (of Ramadan)." Ibn 'Abbas added, "Search for it on the twenty-fourth (of Ramadan)." (Sahih Al- Bukhari).

Ramadan is the (month) in which was sent down the Qur'an, as a guide to mankind, also clear (Signs) for guidance and judgment (Between right and wrong). So every one of you who is present (at his home) during that month should spend it in fasting, but if anyone is ill, or on a journey, the prescribed period (Should be made up) by days later. Allah intends every facility for you; He does not want to put you to difficulties. (He wants you) to complete the pre- scribed period, and to glorify Him in that He has guided you; and perchance ye shall be grateful. Quran (Ch. 2 verse 185).

all that I have sent forward (of sins) and all that I have delayed.

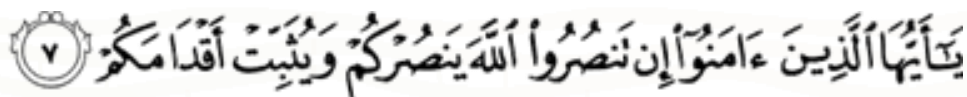
Rabanna Taqbbal minna Innaka Antas Sammeul A'leem.

Note:

1. The time for making the formal intention extends from sunset (Maghrib) until dawn (Fajr) of the day of Ramadan.
2. The prescribed daily hours of fasting extends from dawn to sunset.
3. Times for dawn indicate end of Sahoor (pre-dawn meal); times for Maghrib indicate Iftar (breaking of fast at sunset).
4. Fasting begins 5 minutes before Fajr (dawn time) and ends 5 minutes after sunset (Maghrib times).
5. Tafsiir (Explanation of the Quran verses) during Ramadan starts from 6:00 pm to 7:00 pm.
6. Taraweeh prayer begins at 8:30 pm.
7. Lailat Qadr will be on Friday, April 5th, 2024, @ 10:00 p.m
